In the Name of God So Let it be

Simon Banks of said State and County being of advanced Age and Knowing that I must shortly depart from this world deem it right and proper both as respects myself and and family that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind providence has blessed me I therefore make this my last will and testament written with my own hand and hereby revoking and annulling all others heretofore made by me

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I devise and direct that my body be buried in a Christianlike manner suitable to my circumstance and Condition I commit my Soul to God who gave it with hope of Salvation through the merits of our blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ whose religion I have professed and as I hope have enjoyed for the last fifty years

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I direct that all my just debts to be paid without delay as there is no necessity for my creditors to be delayed of their rights

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give to my beloved wife Matilda with whom I have lived in the strictest quiet and love the last Twenty years my house and plantation wherein I live during her natural life or so long as she may see proper to remain on it reserving to my Daughter Belinda S. Banks the right to live on said place with her Step Mother so long as she may remain single or until her mother relinquishes her claim and they to share equal in the products of the place, I also give to my wife one horse the one she shall chose of my horses and as much of my farming tools as she may think necessary for her use and also one small waggon

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I give to my wife and Daughter all my Stock of Cattle and hogs except two Cows and calves which I give to my Grand daughter fullam Banks, said cattle and hogs to be equally divided between them, the money I have in hand at the time of my decease after paying all my burial expences I give also to my wife and daughter to be equally divided between them,

Item 5<sup>th</sup> I give to my wife one Bedstead and as much Bedding and furniture as she may chose together with as much of my House hold and kitchen furniture as she may chose I also give to my Daughter one Bedstead and Bed and furniture

Item 6<sup>th</sup> I direct that all my perishable property that is not pointed out in the foregoing items to be sold and the money arising by such Sales shall be divided amongst my heirs in manner hereinafter pointed out

Item 7<sup>th</sup> after my wifes decease or when she thinks it best for her interest to relinquish the right I have given her to my plantation I direct that all my lands be sold by my Executors either at public auction or by private contracts and in such lots or settlements as they may see best for the advancement of my Estate and benefit of my heirs,

Item 8<sup>th</sup> the money arising from the sales of my property both real and personal direct to be divided amongst in manner following to wit first two hundred dollars shall be paid to my orphan grand children the sons and daughters of my son Simon C Banks deceased

and one hundred dollars to my son

Whomsoever of them shall be remaining

amount whatever it may be shall be divided into five equal parts shares first paid to my son Gayler Banks second to my son Thomas F Banks third to my Daughter Belinda S Banks fourth to my Orphan Grand Children the Sons and daughters of my son Simeon G Banks fifth to my other Grand Children the Sons and daughters of my son Elisha Banks deceased and also my Grand Son Robert W. Cone to share equal in the fifth division

Item sixth I constitute and appoint my trusty Son Thomas F Banks and my faithful friend Andrew J Wilson Executors to this my last Will and Testament this February the 16<sup>th</sup> 1870
