In the name of God Amen,
 I William G. Desaussure of Charleston
 South Carolina do make publish
 and declare this to be my last will
 and testament thereby amending and
 revoking all former or other wills
 and testaments by me heretofore made
 In witness whereof I order and direct all my
 just and lawful debts to be paid as soon
 after my death as convenient.

Item I give devise and bequeath the
 whole of my property real and personal
 of every kind & nature whether in
 possession expectancy or remainder and
 intaken and wherever situated unto
 my wife Martha G. Desaussure for
 and during her life and from and
 after her death I give devise and
 bequeath the whole of my said property
 to be equally divided among all of
 my children and to and among the
 children of any of my children who
 may be then dead leaving a child or
 children then leaving such child
 or children to take the same in-lieu
 by representation.

Item I authorize and empower my
 Executors & Administrators according to their
 respective Offices to sell and dispose
 of all or any part of my property
 real and personal.

Item I nominate constitute and
 appoint my wife Martha G.
 Desaussure during her life

Sole Testamentary Guardian of all my Children, and after her death I appoint my Brothers Henry W Desaussure and Lewis D Desaussure Testamentary Guardians of all my Children.

Lastly I nominate, constitute and appoint my wife Martha D Desaussure during her life Sole Executrix of this my last will and testament, and after her death I appoint my brother Henry W Desaussure and Lewis D Desaussure Executors of this my last will and testament.
