

Last Will and Testament of Fanney Allen
Burke Co. GA Will Book B

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State of Georgia In the name of God Amen I Frances Allen being
Burke County, duly impressed with the uncertainty of life and being
in a low state of health but of sound and disposing mind and me-
mory, do make this my last will and testament in manner and
form as follows.

Item 1st After the payment of all my just debts I give and bequeath unto my
grand Daughters Sidney Jones the sum of one dollar, I also give &
bequeath unto my grand son Philip & Sapp the sum of two dollars
both Sidney Jones & Philip & Sapp being the children of my Daughter
Frances Sapp wife of Everett Sapp deceased.

Item 2^d I give and bequeath unto my grand children to wit Mary Bell, Wesley
Bell and Caroline Brown the sum of one dollar each they being the
children of my daughter Mary Brantly.

Item 3^d I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Frances Rice the sum of
one dollar she being the daughter of my daughter Ann
deceased.

Item 4th The residue of All the property I have made since the death of my
husband James Allen I want to be equally divided between the following
heirs to wit William Casseter, Hugh Allen, James P. Allen, William Allen, William
Brantly, Thomas & Allison and William B. Hankinson.

Item 5th I do hereby appoint and leave as my whole sole Executors my Esteemed
Sons in Law William Casseter and William B. Hankinson.

Item 6th I do hereby acknowledge this to be my last Will and Testament hereby
revoaking all other wills made by me.

nineteenth day of August Eighteen Hundred and fifty One (1851)

same as witnesses in the presence of each other and of said Testatrix
at her special instance and request.
