

State of Georgia In the name of God Amen.
Jefferson County I Benjamin Brack of said State and County and
knowing that I must shortly depart this life deem it right
and proper both as respects my connection and myself that
I should make a disposition of the property with which
providence has blessed me with. do therefore make th^{is} my
last Will and Testament hereby revoking all others hitherto
made by me.

1st Item I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian
like manner, suitable to my condition and circumstances in life;
my Soul I shall return to rest with God who gave it as I hope for
eternal salvation through the merits and atonement of the blessed
Lord and Savior Jesus Christ whose religion I do profess and as
I humbly trust do now enjoy.

2nd Item. I desire that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Execu-
tors hereinafter appointed. I am unwilling that my creditors
should be delayed in their rights.

3rd Item. I give bequeath and devise to my beloved Sister in Law Jane H
Brack wife of Charles B. Brack my Negro Boy Augustus, yellow
complexioned age four teen years. For her sole and separate use
for and during her natural life, free and exempt from the
debts and liabilities of her present or a future Husband to her
for ever.

4th Item. I give bequeath and devise to my beloved Sister Cintha Brown
formerly Cintha Brack. For her sole and separate use dur-
ing her natural life free and exempt from the debts and
liabilities of her present or a future Husband the following
property (to wit) all the balance of my Negro Property that
I now or may have at the time of my death and there in case
to her for ever.

5th Item. I desire is that my Landed Estate and perishables

property be all sold and my sister Cynthia Brown formerly
Cynthia Brack to have the sole and separate use of the same
during her natural life, free and exempt as specified above
in Item the fourth for ever.

1st Item I desire that all the within property as stated off to my beloved
sister Cynthia Brown formerly Cynthia Brack as in Item fourth
and fifth after her death to be equally divided between her
children except her son Henry who I wish to have Two Hundred
Dollars more to his part than either of the others of her children.

1st Item I hereby leave in Trust all the above property as mentioned
in the different items to my sister in Law and sister and their
children forever.

2nd Item I hereby constitute and appoint my friend Allen Inman an
Executor and Trustee to this my last will and Testament.
