disposition of my son William J. Brinson and the property and
little effects that I have and hold for him as his, therefore make
this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills
heretofore made by me.

Item 1st I desire that my body be buried in a decent and Christianlike
manner my soul I trust shall return to rest with God who
gave it.

Item 2nd I hope that all my just debts will be paid by the representative
of my husband's Estate, as I have no interest in it, save a life
interest, which I think ought to be sufficient to authorize them
to pay the same (my debts)

Item 3rd I desire and direct and hereby appoint my son Middleton J.
Brinson as Guardian for my son William J. Brinson, desiring
him to take charge of his person and what stock he has that has
been given him by other persons brought by me for him consisting
of Stock Cattle Stock goats and one little black filly and some notes
or notes and act as guardian for him.

Item 4th I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved son Middleton J.
Brinson Executor to this my last will and testament this Aug.
12th 1858.
