and gear corn and fodder, Carriages and harness stock
of all kinds horses Mules cattle and hogs with all my
interest in the Estate of the late Green B Red claimed
under marriage settlement made before their inter-
marriage and all other claim or claims that I
may be entitled in said Estate together with all Bonds
notes accounts and other evidences of debt I die
possessed of.

Executors to this my last Will & Testament hereby reso-
lving all other wills made by me. In witness whereof
