

State of Georgia } In the name of God, Amen. I, Amelia Scarborough, being of
Bunche County } sound and disposing mind and memory, and considering the
uncertainty of this mortal life, do make and declare this my last will and
testament, in manner and form following:-

- Item First It is my desire that after my death my body be decently buried in the burying
ground on the premises and near the house of David Perkins dec'd.
- Item Second It is my will that all the notes due me be collected and as much of the money
as shall be necessary, used to pay up all my just debts.
- Item Third I give bequeath and devise to my niece, Emma Perkins, my Negro man Colborn
to her sole and separate use, for and during her natural life, free and exempt from
the debts and liabilities of her future husband, if she should ever marry, and
if she should die without children it is my will that the said Negro man Colo-
born become the property of my younger niece, Ida Amelia Perkins to have and to
hold for her own separate use for and during her natural life free and exempt
from the debts and liabilities of her future husband if she should ever marry.
- Item Fourth I also give and bequeath to my niece Emma Perkins all my bedding and bed clothing
together with all the money which may be left after paying my debts, to her sole and
separate use, for and during her natural life.
- Item Fifth I hereby constitute and appoint my friend David S Perkins to be the guardian of said
property willed and bequeathed to my niece Emma Perkins.
- Item Sixth I hereby constitute and appoint my friend David S Perkins, Executor of this my
last will and testament, Bunche Co. GA Will BK A
www.georgiapioneers.com striking all others heretofore made by me.
- Witness my hand and seal this the twenty seventh day of November in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven.
