Bucks County, I, John McGuire being in a declining state of health, but of sound & disposing mind & memory do make and constitute this my last will & testament hereby revoking all others to wit:

Item 1st I yield my soul to God who gave it &
desire that my body be buried in a decent & Christian
manner.

Item 2nd I desire that all my just debts be paid out of my estate.

Item 3rd I give & bequeath to Wallace Harper of Woodford County, Kentucky my servant girl Betsy in order that he may protect & take care of her in her old age, and also give to the said Wallace Harper my two servant boys Jackson about ten or eleven years old and Albert now about six years old, for and during the life of my aforesaid girl Betsy, the said boys to be hired out by the said Harper and the proceeds of them to be appropriated to the support and

maisntenance of the said girl Betsy - and I also give unto the said Wallace Harper one thousand dollars to be appropriated like wise to the support of Betsy, and at the death of the said Betsy it is my will, that the said boys Jackson & Albert go to those to whom I have hereinafter bequeathed the remainder of my estate Item 4th I give and bequeath to my nephew Daniel McGuire of Kentucky and my niece Nancy Ann Lowry all the remainder of my estate both real and personal consisting of land negroes Money notes accounts bonds, horses, stock household & Kitchen furniture &c to be divided equally between them provided my said Niece Comes to Georgia & live with me until my death, but if my said Niece Nancy Ann Lowry does not come to Georgia and live with me until my death then the whole of my estate mentioned in this Item I will & bequeath to my said Nephew Daniel McGuire.
