 Adam Lawson deceased, which were granted, the property

 Application was afterwards made to remove the Administration
 from the County of Henry to the County of Putt, and it was
 accordingly removed upon the Administrator having given
 bond and security in said County for the faithful discharge
 of his duties, and thus his first return he makes to the Court
 of this County.
