to be my last will and Testament. My desire & will is that all my
Just debts shall be paid.

Item 1st I give and bequeath to the Children of my daughter Lane
Andrews, now deceased, a negro girl named Roda, and her
Increase to be equally divided between them, when the youngest
of my said daughter's Children shall arrive at the age of twenty
one years, my son in law Walter Andrews to keep said negro
girl Roda until that time free of charge or hire.

Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto John Smith in trust for my
daughter Margaret Bennett a certain negro boy named
Mitchel about sixteen years old, to work for Benjamin J.
Bennett & my daughter Margaret Bennett, & at their death
to be equally divided between their Children.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto Benjamin J. Bennett, in Trust,
for my daughter Mary Smith a negro boy named
Simon, about thirteen years old, to work for John Smith
& my daughter Mary Smith, & at their death to be equally
divided between their Children.

Item 4th I give & bequeath to my wife Mary Harrison the plantation
entire, whereon I now live containing about six hundred
acres, & ten negroes, Minta, Lisa, Mary, Nema, Lewis, Dick
Alfred, Liza, George, and Sam, and my stock of horses,
Cattle, hogs, mules, farming utensils, wagons, oxcarts, &c.
all the corn, wheat, oats, & provisions, & every thing which
I have not given, in the foregoing Items of this my last
will & Testament, including all the household & kitchen
furniture.

Item 5th My will & request is that my wife Mary Harrison shall
pay all my Just debts out of her share of my estate.

Item 6th I do hereby constitute & appoint my wife Mary Harrison
executrix to this my last will & Testament.
