my wife to dispose of such of my effects as she can
best spare to pay the balance of my debts—

3rd My wish and will is for my dear wife Eliza
to remain on my land and use every thing that
I possess for the purpose of raising my children
as I would myself, provided never the less, should
my wife choose to sell my land and effects my will
is that the amount arising there from be equally
divided between her and all my children as they
become of age— this 30th June 1850.
