is this day indebted to said James H Stark in the sum of two
hundred and eleven dollars which is a debt against said Estate
independent of his wife legates to bear interest from this date
It is further admitted & acknowledged that Richard L Crawford
in right of his wife Elizabeth L Crawford Augustus Gargile
Charles Gargile John M Gargile & Joseph Pittman in right of
his wife Susan T Pittman have each received from Estate
since the death of said John R Gargile the sum of one thousand

dollars Their respective shares of the first distribution under said will.

It is further admitted & acknowledged & agreed between all of said parties that Frederick George Amelia & Catharine B. Leavitt and Mary Leavitt widow have not received any part of their share of said first distribution. It is further admitted & agreed that said Mary Leavitt & James W. Stark have fully settled of and discharged all debts & claims in the hands of said Stark her attorney or agent & that said Stark has fully accounted with & paid over to said Mary Leavitt Exrs as aforesaid all means collected for her at any time & returned to her all her papers of every kind which he has in possession.

It is further admitted and agreed that said Mary Leavitt has out of her own individual funds at various times advanced for the use of said Estate the sum of two thousand dollars & that sum stands as a debt against said Estate to be paid before any second distribution of said estate shall take place.

It is further admitted and agreed that all the lands meadows & other property acquired by said Mary Leavitt since the death of her husband whether in her own name or as executrix is property of said Estate & the said Mary Leavitt hereby covenants & agrees to stand seque of the same to use set forth in said will. And all the debts owing by said Mary Leavitt are hereby admitted & acknowledged to be incumbrances on said Estate and subject to be paid out of said Estate & it is further admitted and acknowledged that all and singular the actions and damages of said Mary Leavitt as Exrs as aforesaid have been legal just & equitable and the said legacies hereby forever release the said, the said Mary Leavitt just legal liabilities whatsoever on account of irregularities in her returns or want of returns or on account of any neglect or illegal conduct of hers in managing said Estate and said legacies all admit that she has managed the affairs of said estate prudently, carefully & lawfully and she relinquishes all claims & interest on the above mentioned arrangements made for said Estate and all commissions for managing the same.
