make and publish this my last will & Testament in
manner and form following, that is to say
After my Just debts are all paid I give to my beloved
Wife Ann Smith, all my Stock of Horses, Hogs,
Cattle and Household and Kitchen furniture.
2nd I leave to my beloved Wife her life time two Negroes to wit
Molly & Charlotte also one hundred Acre of Land sit
being one half of Lot No 186 in the 1st District of the County
aforesaid.
3rd I Give to my daughter Nancy C. Smith one of the best
born living Children that may be born from the body
of said Molly or Charlotte. Also one hundred Acre of
Land after her Mother's death. I being the same last
her Mother also one bed and furniture.
4th I Give to my daughter Mary & Martha H. Brown &
Nancy C. Smith after their Mother's death the said Molly
& Charlotte to be equally divided between them three.
5th I Give to my sons to wit, John, Wm. A. Hester
William & Marshall Smith, \$500 each & Hapsey one
\$200 each,
6th and lastly I hereby nominate & appoint my beloved
Wife Ann Smith & Nicholas Brown Executors
to this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all
former Wills by me made. In Witness whereof I have

in the year of our Lord, One thousand Eight
hundred & Twenty three,
