It is therefore Ordered that the said George T. Speaks be

appointed Guardian of said Thomas and also of Mary

Pinckney & Samuel Pinckney Other heirs of the said Samuel

which last are under the age of fourteen years, and

George T. Speaks and Green Blackston came into Court and

swore themselves in the sum of eight hundred dollars

in the faithful performance of said trust, and the

said Guardian was duly qualified
