Jasper County, Eli Conger, James D. Burks, & Ezekiel Walker
are held and firmly bound unto the Justice of the Court of Ordina-
ry and their successors in office in the first sum of six hundred
Dollars, payable by the said Eli Conger, James D. Burks,
and Ezekiel Walker, or either of them their heirs, executors,
administrators or assigns, jointly and severally to be void on
condition, that if the said Eli Conger shall do and perform the
duty of Guardianship for the persons and property of Cynthia
Spear, Edger Spear, and Henry Spear, Orphans of Joseph Spear
as the law requires of him, otherwise to remain in full force
Power and Virtue,
