a boy, Clark a boy, Warren a boy, Mary a Girl Child, together with
all my Hony, Stock of every kind, Household & Kitchen & Plantation
furniture, debts, property and Interests of every species be sold & disposed
Of & Realized in cash Or on credit at the discretion of my
Executors hereinafter named, & that the proceeds of all which property
& Interests, after the payment of all Just debts owing by & claimed on
me, be equally & Jointly divided between, given to, and mutually shared
in halves by my two loving Children Lorena the wife of Thomas Hanfton
And my Daughter Caroline, and to them alone, Reserving & giving how
ever to my former wife Sarah, first Sarah Wimpsey the sum of six and
One fourth Cents, and to her two Children at present living with me
named Elizabeth & Olive, each the sum of six and One fourth Cent.
And for the enforcement and execution of this my last and Only will
& Testament I hereby constitute and Appoint Thomas Hanfton and
William Gilmore my Executors sole & special therein
