


History of St. Marys, Georgia, and Vicinity.

The blue line, added to this map, is an effort to show the present, approximate, position of Point Peter Creek, and the St. Marys River. The red marker shows the little that is now left of the site of Fort Pickering (destroyed by the British in war of 1812), and presumed to also be the site of Fort Tonym, destroyed by the British in 1778.
