Item 4th I deem at the death or intermarriage of my wife as when the youngest child shall marry or be of age that all my property be sold and an equal distribution be made between my legal representatives with the exception of my son James B. Strawn to whom I give & bequeath to him the sum of two hundred Dollars to be paid to him by my executor at the time of the distribution of the balance of my estate among the balance of my legal representatives in the said James B. Strawn being herefore provided for in part.

Item 5th

I constitute and appoint my beloved wife Susan, executor to this my last Will & Testament.
