State of Georgia } In the name of God Amen
Campbell County } I Amsted Bomar Sen. of the
County and State aforesaid being
of sound mind and disposing memory but know-
ing that it is appointed unto all men to
die do make this my Last will and Testament
in manner and form following to wit.
first I give and bequeath my Soul to God
Secondly my desire is to be Buried in a decent
and Christianlike manner.
Thirdly as touching my worldly Effects I desire
that a reasonable quantity of land be attached
to my Mill and Ferry and to be sold to pay my
Just debts or so much of any other property
as my Executors may think most advisable for
the same.
Fourthly I give and bequeath all the remain-
der of my property to my wife Elizabeth Bomar
during her natural life or widowhood and at
her death to be disposed of in the following
manner to wit. (1st) first I give and be-
queath unto my Son Spencer Bomar all
that body of land lying before the Lane
commencing at the Ferry and running with the
Lane to the mouth and as the Road now runs
to the mill until it comes to where said

17 Road ~~from the~~ ^{below} the mill
thence across the Creek parallel to Austin A.
Arnolds Land thence along said Arnolds Line to
the River and up the west Side of the River to the
Beginning; I also bequeath to my Son Spencer Roman
Two Hundred Acres of wood Land commencing at
the mouth of the Lane running from the Ferry in
a direct Line to the Big Spring thence from said
Spring to the Back ~~line~~ ^{line} of No one hundred and
Eighteen so as to Include two Hundred acres after
deducting what is allowed for the mill.

I also Bequeath to my Son Spencer Roman my
Medical Books I also Bequeath to my Son Spencer
one Old Negro woman by the name of Zeebe at
the vocation of Disinterested Men as a part of
his Dividende of my Estate

(3rd) I Give and bequeath unto my Grand daughter
Elizabeth Rice Daughter of Thos. S. Ward Esq.
Rice a certain Negro Girl by the name of
Martha.

(3rd) I give and bequeath unto my Daughter in
Law Francis Roman widow of my Deceased son
Elisha S. Roman ~~the~~ Dollars.

(4th) I Give and bequeath unto my Grand son
Elisha S. Roman Son of Elisha and Francis Roman
\$300.00

(5th) It is my will and desire that all the
Land on the west Side of the River above the
Lane be divided in to Five Lots as my Executors
may think most proper and to be sold for
the benefit of my heirs after the death of my
wife also all my Land on the east Side of the
Chattahoochee below the Town of Vaneppsbottom
to be sold after the death of my wife for the
benefit of my heirs and I also further desire that
all my Land after leaving a sufficient

quantity of the Ferry above the
Bower of Campbellton and on the East Side
of the Chattahoochee to be divided into three
lots as my Executors my Direct to be sold after
the Death of Wife for the benefit of my heirs
also I desire all my Lands lying in the State
of South Carolina to be sold as my Executors
thinks proper for the benefit of my heirs—
I will and desire all my Property Real &
personal not Otherwise Bequeathed to be
Sold after the death of my wife to the highest
bidder and the proceeds thereof Equally divided
amongst my Children to wit My Daughter
Susan McMullin Mary Rice & Lewis Rice John
Roman Spencer Roman and Amstet Roman
or their Heirs.

(6th) I do hereby appoint my Spencer Roman
and Edward F. Roman my Lawfull Executors
to this my Last will and Testament Pervert-
ing all other wills heretofore made by me.
In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and affixed my Seal this Twenty
Eighth day of December 1839
