God to bless me I dispose of in the following manner to wit

all my house hold and kitchen furniture consisting
of beds bedsteads and their furniture Flat Tables glass
& crockery ware of every kind Knives & forks pots and
& skillets Shovel & long water Pails washing tub chest
& Trunk of every kind Cane Candles molds and
Candle Sticks Tins Barrels &c. judges can Sinner John can
or every kind Spinning wheel Cards bread water bread
Trays Knife Box smoothing irons axes hand bot & sitting chair
all my books of every kind with every other article
that appertains to my household & the better of my affairs
I also give and bequeath to my beloved wife all my
Corn & meat and my entire stock of hogs and cows
& calves and one side Saddle and one mans saddle and
my waggons and gear & harness with all my plantation
Tools of every description and blind. Mule loom slays &c
with every other article I am possessed with of every kind
all the above named property is given and bequeath
to my beloved wife

to live on her and enjoy in any manner she may
think proper and be at her entire disposal—
after all my just debts if any shall be paid
or is paid,

Lastly I constitute & appoint my beloved wife
Leticia Brazel my Sole Executor to execute
this my last will and Testament.

5th I desire that my beloved Wife Nancy Garbrough keep
the possession of all the property untill my children
shall become of age

6th I give & bequeath unto my Sons Moriah Greenberry
George Charles Garbrough 1 Dollar in Cash

7th I give to my Daughters Elizabeth Sarah Mary one dollar
in Cash
