& Trunkes of every kind. Cans. Candle molds and
Candle sticks guns barrels &c jewels our Siving jar
or every kind Spinning wheel & cards bread water bran
Fryng knife. Box smoothing ironas also ~~bod~~ hot & fitting chairs
all my books of every kind with every other article
that appertains to my house hold & Kitchen affairs
I also give and bequeath to my beloved wife all my
corn & meat and my entire stock of hogs and cows
& calves and our side saddle and one mans saddle and
my waggon and gins & harwest with all my plantation
tools of every description and blinds. more corn than she
with every other article I am possessed with of every kind
all the above named property is given and bequeath
to my beloved wife Elizabeth Agate

I do live on my land in my name the way
I have $\frac{1}{2}$ proper and the other $\frac{1}{2}$ wife disposed
of after all my just debts if any shall be paid
or is paid,

Secondly I constitute & appoint my beloved wife
Lertitia Bragual my sole Executor to execute
this my last will and Testament.

of October 1833 make & publish this my last

Garborough Lot of Land containing 202^{1/2} Acres lying
in the Ninth District Fayette County.

(2nd) I give and bequeath unto my Sons Joshua & Garborough
Thomas J. Garborough the Lot of Land upon which
I now live as No 98 formerly Fayette now Campbell County
(the said lot to be equally divided between the two.)

(3rd) I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter -
Eleanor Garborough one Cow & Calf & another bed &
furniture.

(4th) I desire that all my just debts be paid

(5th) I desire that my beloved Wife Nancy Garborough keep
the possession of all the property until my Children
shall become of age

(6th) I give & bequeath unto my Sons Micah Greenberry
George Charles Garborough 1 Dollar in Cash

(7th) I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Sarah Murray one dollar
in Cash
