of sheep together with all the Household & Kitchen
furniture also the Plantation whereon I ~~now~~ reside
my wife shall have so long as she may stay thereon

It is my will and desire that my daughter
Lucinda J. Burson wife of James Burson have
for her own use during her life and at her death
her bodily heirs Margaret a negro girl seven or
eight years old Lily a negro girl five or six years
old & Peter a boy about twelve years old

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Fourth

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It is my will and desire that my son
David of Darnock have Moany a negro girl seven
or eight years old Perry a boy five or six years old
Pleuca a negro woman seventeen or eighteen years
old together with her increase

Fifth

It is my will and desire that my son James
of Darnock have a negro boy John about ten
years old Amanda a girl about six years old
& a negro woman Ann fifteen or sixteen years old
together with her increase

Sixth

It is my will and desire in case of the
death or marriage of my wife Caloun that then
my daughter Lucinda J. Burson wife of James
Burson shall have the negro woman Britta
about thirty five years old and my son David
of Darnock shall have the negro woman

Delpha and my son James M. Darnell

It is my will and desire that
the remainder of my effects now heretofore disposed
of be equally divided amongst my three children
