First I Give and bequeath to my Beloved

Warren & Robert Early the Children of my
Beloved Son Lovett Davitt for an equal
Interest in a Negro Woman Hannah - Secondly
I give & bequeath unto my beloved Grand Chil-
dren Overton Fletcher Eliza Garland Matilda
Ann Lacey Sarah James Thomas Lovett Harriet John
Andrew & Mary Overton the Children of my
Beloved Son Overton for an equal
and Joint Interest in my negro Woman Sarah
& her Child Amy and it is my Will and desire
that the said Negro should be subject to the
Control and management of my said two Sons
respectfully unto & such time as the youngest
child of either comes of age then the said Negro
Woman ~~Hannah~~ Hannah to be sold & the money
Equally divided in half I should have a child
in children in that case they may be divided or
sold & divided as my said Son Lovett may think
best and when the youngest child of my said
Son William shall become of age then my
will is that the said Negro Sarah and
Child Amy with any increase that may
be shall be equally divided amongst the
Children of my said Son William -
But as the said Negro Woman Hannah

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is at this time as I understood Lewis
 up again by Virtute of an Execution from
 Clark County and may possibly be
 sold under said Execution My will
 & desire is that in case she should be
 sold that all the above named Children
 of both my sons aforesaid shall be
 Jointly and Equally Intrested in the
 Remaining Negroes and it is my will
 and desire that my two beloved sons
 Lovett Davenport and William
 Davenport be the Executors of this my
 Last will and Testament and likewise
 that they Equally divide between them
 - selves the remaining part of my Property
 & that they sell a certain Lot of Land
 lying in the County of Campbell Number Thirty
 Six in the first District (formerly
 Carroll) in such manner and at such
 times as they may Judge proper and divide
 the Money between them selves
