of all I give my soul to God who gave it and
my body to be buried in a plain christian burial
manner with out any pomp or pride at the discretion
of my Executors and as to the worldly goods wherewith
it hath pleased God to bless me with I bequeath
in the following manner (Witness)

And I will that all my personal property
be sold and all ^{not lawfully accepted} ~~just debts~~ ~~and~~ ~~the~~
Mr. collector and after paying all my just
debts what should be left, I will and
bequeath to be equally divided among my
brother John M. Thompsons & children of Chat-
tanooga County Children Consisting of ~~Six~~, Also
I will and bequeath all my Town lots and
lands in said County to be leased or rented
until the said J. M. Thompsons Children
shall be come of age or to the chuse by them
Selves or Guardian whether or not to sell the
same Town lots and lands as a fore said &
I do will and bequeath all Rents or Issues
a Rising from the same to them until such
Time as they or their Guardian or my Executor
shall think best to have the same sold and

erty and lands as I now hold I will and bequeath
the same to be equally divided among the
said J. M. Thompsons & Children as aforesaid
