Considering the uncertainty of this mortal
life and being of sound and disposing perfect
mind and memory blessed be Almighty God, for
His Name; I Hugh Rouin of the County
of Campbell and State of Georgia, do make
publish and confirm this my last will &
Testament - www.georgiapioneers.com from following that
is to Say;

1st I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Nancy Moon a certain negro Girl Martha -
now in my possession to her and her heirs to
be disposed of as she may think proper.

2nd I give and bequeath unto my son James
Rouin lot of land known as number one
hundred and thirty two in the tenth District of
Carroll County for his special use and benefit
so long as he lives and not to be subject to his
debts in any way; and after his death the said
lot or its proceeds to be equally divided between his
two young sons Loren & Vincent Rouin.

3rd I give and bequeath unto my daughter
son John Rouin and his heirs a negro boy
Naniel West which he now has in his possession
in fee simple forever.

4th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah
word one negro woman by the name of Jude
and all of her children and her future increase
for the special benefit of my said daughter subject
to the disposal of as she may think proper.

5th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eliza
Bourne one negro man by the name of Ben
subject to be disposed of by her and him only.

6th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Polly
Higginbotham one negro girl Caroline and her
increase which said girl is now in her possession
subject to her disposal and hers only.

7th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eady
the sum of five hundred dollars subject to
her disposal and hers only.

8th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Catherine

one negro girl by the name of Margabb

in her possession and increase subject to his

disposal and his only, provided nevertheless that

should my said daughter Catherine die without

leaving a child or children then and in that case

the said negro and her increase to be given to my

son John Bonin and his heirs.

9th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eliza

Bonin three negroes Wiley a boy Orange a boy

and Amanda a girl which said negroes shall

be subject to the use of my beloved wife Sally

until my daughter Eliza arrives to the age

of twenty one years.

10th I give and bequeath unto my infant son

Hugh Bonin three negroes Gabriel a boy Mary a

girl and Linnard an infant child which said

negroes shall be subject to the use of my beloved

wife Sally until my son Hugh arrives to the

age of twenty one years.

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This my last will hereby revoking all former
ones by me made.

In testimony whereof the said Hugh Bonin has
hereunto set his hand affixed his seal this 15th
day of August 1862
