Item 4th I give and devise to my beloved

I have lived in the strictest quiet &
love for forty years; a city and

in the Seventh District of Originally
Cannons now Campbell County the
place where I now live with all

the right of disposal & opportunity
as to said parcel of land in any
wise appertaining or belonging from
from all charges or limitations to
be ever proper over herself & her heirs
forever with full power to dispose
of it as she deems proper at her
death; also I give and bequeath
to my wife Betsey Mayfield in the
same unreserved manner Eleven
hundred dollars which is now in
hand together with all notes and
bonds and all other evidences of
debt, all my stock consisting of one
Mare and Cows sheep and hogs &
all my household and kitchen
furniture.
