Item First I will and desire that all my
~~outstand~~ debts be paid and for that purpose I
desire that my Executor hereinafter named first
collect all that is due and if that be not suff-
icient then that all my real estate be sold for
the purpose of paying my debts and to effect
that object I hereby my Executor is hereby author-
ized and empowered to sell at private or public sale
in my deem best said real estate after first
my stock and all personal property my
excepted which I mean shall in no case be
sold to pay debts until the whole of the
value of my estate is paid.

Item Second I give and bequeath unto Richard
Moore his heirs and assigns after the payment
of my debts the whole balance of my estate
both real and personal of whatever kind the
same may be to him and his heirs from
this request & injunction that he keep my
servants all together in three families and that
the said Richard Moore his heirs & administrators
& Executors shall see that my said servants shall be
well provided for kindly treated & their condition
in life made as comfortable as all the circum-
stances will permit.

Item Third I hereby nominate & appoint the said Richard
Moore the Executor to this my last will and Testament
to see the same carried into effect according to my above
expressed wishes

in testimony of the foregoing I hereunto set
my hand and seal this the twentieth day of
February Eighteen hundred and forty one

 uncertainty of the time when I shall be called
 to my ^{last} ~~house~~ do make ordain and declare this
 to be my last will and Testament hereby revoking
 all others in name and form Following viz- First
 of all I give my soul to God who gave it and
 my body to be buried in a plain christian burial
 manner with out any pomp or pride at the discretion
 of my Executors and as to the worldly goods wherewith
 it hath pleased God to bless me with I dispose
 in the following manner (I am over
