except three acres and three fourth of an acre, in the
south east corner of said lot—said three acres and
three fourths of an acre lying south east of a certain
Road running through said corner of said lot, and
fifty five acres as the line now runs, in lot
number sixteen said lots all lying in the seventh
district of originally Coweta but now DeKalb
County, with all the rights, minerals and appurten-
ances to said lots of land in any wise apper-
taining or belonging, together with all the
plantation tools and all the house hold and
kitchen furniture and one sorrel Horse about
three years old, one black mare about three
years old and one mare colt between one and two
years old one yoke open one of naggin two or three
and all my stock of cattle and all my tools
