that I should make a disposition of
my property with which a kind Providence
has blessed me do therefore make this my last
will and Testament hereby revoking all
Others heretofore made by me.

1st Item I desire that my body be buried
in a decent and Christian like manner
suitable to my circumstances and condition
in life

2nd Item I desire and direct that all my
just debts be paid without delay by my
Executors hereafter appointed as I am
unwilling my Creditors should be delayed
in their rights especially as there is no neces-
sity for delay.

3rd Item I give and bequeath to my beloved
Wife Mary Ann Hoggood an equal portion
of my property my Daughter Jenneth
(Hoggood) during her widowhood or good
behavior and at her marriage or death to
be divided equally among my children

4th Item I give and bequeath to my
Daughter Percilla Genneth over and
above my other children one Negro Girl
about twelve years old of a fair complexion
by the name of Susan to have forever
and I further bequeath that my
Daughter Percilla Genneth have an

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1st Equal portion of all my other property
with my other children

5th Item I give and bequeath to my
Grand Child Lewis Hobgood and his
Brother Thomas Hobgood one hundred
and fifty dollars each

6th Item I give and bequeath to my
Grandchild Willis Wright-Hobgood
and his Sister Cecilla one hundred
and fifty dollars each

7th Item I will and bequeath that
all my other property be equally divid-
ed = between my children W. P. Hobgood
H. B. Hobgood Cecilla Gensette Hobgood
and James Hobgood excepted that
James Hobgood is to have four hundred
dollars less than the rest of my children
owing to what I have given him heretofore

8th Item I hereby constitute my worthy friend
John A. Boram executor of this my last-
Will and Testament This 1st day of April 1848
