estate I dispose of as follows.

First, It is my will and desire that all
my debts both real & personal be
paid & contented at the shortest notice
and that the balance of my estate
be paid and after paying all
my just debts, I desire that the balance
of the proceeds be disposed of in the
following manner.

First it is my will, I desire that my
two youngest daughters Elizabeth & Ann
& Sarah Francis Childs are to be paid
& each of them that they have two hundred
dollars each more than they have
and that my daughter Martha Caroline
Childs have one hundred dollars
more than my boys then the
remainder of my estate to be equally
divided between all my children
except my son Daniel P. Childs who
shall have fifteen dollars do another
year his part for imports already
given him

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Decd. I do hereby constitute & appoint
my friends John H. Wilson &
James M. Cantrell the Executors
to this my last Will & Testament
and request them to carry it out
according to its face.
