Item Second, I desire and direct that all my just
 debts be paid without delay by my Executor herein
 after named as I am unwilling my Creditors should
 be delayed of their rights especially as there is no
 necessity for delay.

Item Third, I give and devise or bequeath to my
 beloved children, Robert Sherman & his wife Nancy
 Ten Dollars to my dear friend Stalling, Ten Dollars
 to my son Lincoln Stalling, Ten Dollars to my son
 Jesse Stalling One Dollar to my son Jeremiah
 W. Stalling Ten Dollars and also Ten Dollars to my
 Grand children; The children of Andrew W. Stalling
 the remainder of my property I desire to be equally
 divided between my two daughters Sarah S. Shultz
 and Louisa Shultz the wife of Charles Becker
 (then forth) I desire that my Executor herein after
 named; shall immediately proceed on my death to

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to qualify himself and take charge of all my estate and dispose of it at publick sale in a legal & lawful manner and I further more desire that my negroes shall all be sold to one man at publick sale or in terms of the law; I am unwilling to have them separated as they are but one family of them; the names of my negroes are, Glasseo old negro man his wife Jenny & their two children;

Item fifth) I constitute and appoint George Cook of the County of Campbell & State aforesaid my Executor to this my last will and Testament this the 29th day of October in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred and forty six
