I Thomas Camp being in sound mind, and knowing
it right and proper that I should make this
my last Will and Testament (revoking all
others in the name of God - Amen
Item 1st I desire that my body be decently
buried in a Christian like manner.
Item 2 I desire that all of my just debts be
paid.

Item 3rd I will and bequeath unto my beloved
Wife Letitia Camp all of my Estate both
real & personal to wit: all of my lands, and
all of my servants, and all of my
stock of every description, horses, mules
cows, hogs & sheep, also all of the household
& kitchen furniture. I desire
that all of the above named property
should vest in the right of my Wife
during her lifetime or widowhood in the

purpose of raising and educating our
young children; and at the death in
marriage of my wife I desire that all of my
above named property should be sold
and equally divided between all of my
legates.

Item 4th I desire that my three children
Marion or becoms of age and have that they
have the same amount of property given
off to them as those have had. That is Marion's
Wife (to wit;) a horse bridle & saddle a Cow
& calves, four & pigs a bee & furniture
and clothing utensils.

Item 5th I desire that my grand son Robert
C. Smith orphan child of Hugh Smith do
be raised in & with my family since that
my grand son be his guardian and the
principal of his estate. That I have given
him father's estate I desire should not
be touching which is seven hundred
and forty dollars.

Item 6th I appoint my wife and my
son Wilson C. Camp my executors of this
my last will & Testament.
