like manner at the discretion of my executor not
doubting but that it will be raised again in the
morning of the resurrection and as to the worldly
goods wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me I
dispose of in the following manner to wit.

I will and begeth to my beloved daughter Martha
Dillon (for her part) all she has taken of me in
my infirmed state) all my share part portion claims
and interest in & to the Estate of my son John
Dillon deceased who died without bodily issue
after giving her son John M. Dillon out of it
Three hundred Dollars for the purpose of buying
him a piece of land & her two daughters Amanda
Dillon and Polly Dillon a good horse bridle & saddle & also
the balance of my share part portion claims & interest
in and to the Estate of my son John Dillon deceased
both real & personal it is my will and desire That my
beloved daughter Martha Dillon should possess and
enjoy it all during her natural lifetime & at the
death of my beloved daughter Martha Dillon it is
my will and desire that it should be equally divided
among the the bodily issue of my daughter Martha
Dillon.
