My Will is that the remainder of my property
After paying all my just debts be left
together with my youngest child Mary
Elizabeth Warren Taliaferro shall arrive
at the age of Twenty One or marry in either
Case my daughter Milverne shall have
the sum of Three hundred Dollars, and the
Remainder to be divided Equally among
my other children & wife, Or in Case
of my Wifes Death or marriage then said
Division shall take place just as if
my youngest Child had become of age.
Lastly I do constitute ~~my~~ my
wife Mary E. Raining Executor & my Brother
in Law Charles B. Taliaferro executor of this
my last Will.

 said will as witnesses in the presence of
 the Testator and at his special instance
 & request and in the presence of each
 other; and deponents further say that
 they saw J. B. Watts sign the same as witness
 also sworn to & subscribed before me
 this 7th Jan 1858
