Mind and Memory and being desirous to settle
all my worldly affairs while I have thought-
to do so, do make and Publish this my Last-
Will and Testament thereby revoking all Wills by
me at any time heretofore made, And first I
Commend my Soul to God who gave it and my
body I commend to the Earth to be buried in decent form my
Wishes retain I dispose of as follows
It is my Will and desire that all my
Just debts be punctually paid by my executor
herein after named

Item Bond It is my Will and desire that after
the payment of all my just debts and funeral
expenses that my whole estate both real
and personal be kept together for the support
of my wife Sarah Ann Roberts and for the
support education and maintenance of my
Children that the same be managed in that way
as will be most conducive to their several
interests that my said wife shall hold the
same in possession until my youngest child
shall reach the age of twenty one
years and after that time the same
to be equally divided between my said

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Wife if live my and my Children of my said
Share and Share alike and if any of the
Should depart this life before the said time then
the same to be divided among the remaining ones in
the same manner as before mentioned

Item 3rd It is my Will and desire that my
Beloved Wife Sarah Ann Roberts as aforesaid
be my executrix to carry my Will into effect and
she is hereby so appointed by her complying with
the Law in such Cases made and provided

Item 4th I do further appoint my said wife
as aforesaid Trustee or Testamentary Guardian
for all my Children and it is my desire that she
carry all the above and foregoing provisions into
effect - In witness whereof I the said Wiley Roberts
to this the above and foregoing Items have set my
hand and seal this 15th day of May 1860
