1st I give devise and bequeath to my beloved wife

be disposed of at her own will and pleasure
To whom she pleases

I do give devise and bequeath to my said wife
all the residue of my ~~my~~ property of every
kind both Real and personal during her natural
Life

2^d It is my will that my said wife give off an
Equal portion of my estate provided she can
Spend the same (which she can do or not do at
her own pleasure) To my beloved daughter Ann Foster
and the heirs of her body And my son Elisha
P Bonnar and to my son Edward B Bonnar child-
-dren and to my daughter Catherine McCaskey
and the heirs of her body and Charge them
with what she lets them have

3rd My will is that at the death of my said
wife all and singular my property of every
Description both Real and personal except
the Negro girl Noyanna above bequeathed be
Equally divided among my children and grand-
children to wit Ann Foster and the heirs of her
body Elisha P Bonnar Catherine McCaskey and
the heirs of her body and my son Edward B
Bonnars children and my grand son
William W Bonnar son of Edward P Bonnar

deceased is to have an equal portion of ~~36~~
my Estate both Real and personal when ~~ever~~
the distribution takes place at the death of my
said wife or at such time as my son Elisha
P. Bomar may think proper to give him his
portion of my Estate to wit at the age of twenty
one years my said grand son is to have his
portion of my Estate and the same to remain
his during his natural life time and if
he dies without a family ~~or~~ without being
the lawful father of a child or children then
this portion or part of my estate is to ~~be~~ go back
to my ~~family~~ children and grand children as
aforesaid

3^{thly} My son Adam M. Bomar & my daughter
Catherine Mclearley Ann Foster have and
use an ~~equal portion of my estate~~ free from
any claim or claims that may be brought
against my son A. M. Bomar Joel Foster &
David Mclearley during their natural lives
at their death to be divided equally among
their children as aforesaid

lastly I appoint my son Elisha P. Bomar my
Executor
