Thirdly I will and bequeath to my first child
as follows To my son Wiley A Chilton I bequeath
one silver watch To my three daughters namely

Mahalia A Chilton I bequeath each one feather
Bed & its furniture that they are now in possession
of my son Wiley A Chilton I bequeath one
Walnut Bedstead & three Mergon Constitute
