Item 2nd I desire and direct that all my Just

is no necessity for delay.

Item 3rd I give & devise to my son John a
parcel of land being a part of Lot Number seven
six (76) in the seventh district of Coweta now Camp-
bell County containing one Hundred and fifty
& a half acres more or less being the fifth part of

and Lot with all the rights-members appurtenances
to said parcel of Land in any wise appertaining
and belonging forever.

Item fourth I give & devise to my Grand son James
Hatchford forty acres of Land on the north side of
Lot Number seventy six (76) in the seventh District of
Coveta now Campbell County the same being forty acres
out of the Lot given & devised to my son John in this
Will given to my Grand son James Hatchford with
all the rights-members & appurtenances to said forty
acres of Land in any wise belonging and appertaining
forever. I also give & bequeath to my Grandson
James Hatchford one bed & the necessary bed clothing
to him & his heirs forever.

Item fifth I give & devise to my two beloved Daughters
Sarah I and Mary I equally Lot of Land Number
fiftytwo in the seventh District of Coveta now Camp-
bell County the place whereon now live with all the
rights-members & appurtenances to said Lot of Land
in any wise appertaining and belonging forever.
I also give and bequeath to my beloved Sarah I
& Mary I all the household & kitchen-furniture
all the bedding and furniture belonging thereto
with the exception of one bed & necessary clothing
given to my Grandson James Hatchford. To my
beloved daughter Sarah I I give and bequeath my
Bolt mare Side Saddle & bridle & to my beloved
daughter Mary I my mare Wilbon & Bolt Side
Saddle & bridle two cows & calves to each such
as they may choose of all my Cattle also all my
stock hogs & sheep and a sufficiency of Corn
 fodder wheat & oats for one year and the contents
of the Smoke House all the bees & poultry belong-
ing to the Plantation equally and my beloved Sarah
I one Shovel & one Sutor plow with one pair of

trace chains also to my beloved daughter
I one shobel & scuter plough with a pair of
chains To Sarah I one negro boy about three years
old by the name of Alfred To Mary I one negro
girl by the name of Sarah about three years old
The said real estate to them and their children
forever.

Item sixth the rest of my property of every descrip-
-tion (with the exception of my rifle gun which
I will and bequeath to my son John) I will &
desire my Executor to sell to the highest-bidder
and divided in the following manner (26)

Item seventh I give and bequeath to my beloved
daughter Margaret Gibson wife of Joseph Gibson
or the wife of any future husband fifty Dollars

Item eight I give and bequeath ^{after} all my last
debts be paid out of the balance of the aforesaid

remaining property in Item the sixth to be equal-
ly divided between Eliza Henderson the wife of
Ezekiel Henderson or the wife of any future
husband and Ely C Collins the wife of Mr C Collins
or the wife of any future husband and Sarah
I and Mary I and John English.

Item ninth I constitute and appoint my worthy
and trusty friend John R. Horton Executor to this
my last will and Testament and also Trustee

For my three beloved Daughters Sarah I and
Mary I English if he will be so good as to act
as such for them This the fourth (4) day of Sep-

-tember in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred
and forty eight (1848)
