to the tenors and effect of said note the said Samuel Burns hath bargained and sold to the
said David CLOPTON a certain certain negro man named Buck, now in the possession
of the said Burns about thirty eight years old to have and to hold the said negro
man Buck to the only proper use benefit and behoof of the said David CLOPTON
his heirs and assigns forever the Condition of the above said of Mortgage is such
that if the said Samuel Burns and Bennett Smith or either of them shall well and
truly pay the said sum of three hundred and thirty three dollars and thirty three cents
according to the tenors and effect of the said promissory note above mentioned at the
time mentioned in said note for the payment thereof - then the above mentioned

full force and virtue this the fourth day of January 1834
