This Indenture made this the twenty second day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty five Between John Watson of the County of Coweta & State aforesaid of the one part & Isham Rainey of the County & State first aforesaid Wilkeseth that the said John Watson hath this day made & delivered to the said Isham & Rainey his certain promissory note described with his own hand & bearing given date with these presents whereby the said John Watson hath promised to pay the said Isham & Rainey or bearer Three hundred & eleven Dollars eighty eight cents on or before the twenty fifth day of December next ensuing the date hereof for value received & so for an entire consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars by the said Isham & Rainey to the said John Watson in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged as well as for the better securing the payment of the aforesaid promissory note The said John Watson hath granted bargained & sold & doth by these presents grant bargain & sell unto the said Isham & Rainey his heirs & assigns three negro slaves to wit Eliza a woman about twenty years of age & her two girl children Elzey about five years of age & Carem about four months of age to have & to hold said bargained & sold negroes to him the said Isham & Rainey his heirs & assigns to his & their own proper use benefit & behoof forever & the said John Watson for himself his heirs executors & administrators the said bargained negroes slaves unto the said Isham & Rainey well warrant & forever defend against the claim of himself & his heirs & against the claim of all other persons whatever Provided never the less that if the said John Watson his heirs executors & administrators shall & do will & truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Isham &

Rainey his heirs & assigns the aforementioned sum of three hundred & eleven Dollars eighty eight cents on the day & time mentioned & appointed for the payment thereof in the said promissory note mentioned with lawful interest for the same according to the tenor of said note then & from thenceforth as well this present mortgage & the right to the property thereby conveyed as the said promissory note shall come determine & be void to all intents & purposes In testimony whereof the said John Watson hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & year above writing Signed Sealed & delivered in presence of William B Boyer
