I, Mrs Missouri Louise Stewart, of said State and County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament.

Item First. I desire that all my just debts be paid.

Item Second. I desire and direct that enough of my property be sold by my executors hereinafter named, either at public or private sale as they deem best, so will bring the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4000⁰⁰) which sum I direct to be turned over to my three sons, viz: W. J., C. H., and Edwin Stewart as trustees for my daughter Allie Stewart Shaw. The same to be a trust fund to be managed by the said trustees for the benefit of said Allie Stewart Shaw during her natural life. The said trustees are directed to turn over to the said Allie Stewart Shaw the interest, rents and profits derived from said fund, the corpus in no case to be encroached upon. The said trustees are given discretion to invest said trust fund or use the same in such manner as they think best for the interest of said aforesaid trust. If at the time of the death of said Allie Stewart Shaw all her children are of full age then I direct that the trustees herein named equally divide all money and property held by them as trustees as aforesaid among the children of said Allie Stewart Shaw. Should said Allie Stewart Shaw leave any

minor child at the time of her death then I direct that the said trustees hold all the money and property in their hands as trustees as aforesaid until the said minor becomes of age when an equal division is to be made. The said Allie Stewart-Shaw to have only a life estate in the legacy created by this item of my will.

Item Third. I direct that all the remainder of my estate of every class and description be equally divided among my children. The share coming under this item of my will to my daughter Allie Stewart-Shaw to be turned over to the trustees named in the first item of my will. It is my purpose and intention that all the property devised to Allie Stewart-Shaw under the provisions of this will to be hers only during her natural life and the same to be turned over to the trustees hereinbefore named to be by them managed for the use and benefit of said Allie Stewart-Shaw for her life, and at her death to be equally divided among her children should they all be of age, and if any of her children are minors the said property to be held together until all are of age and then divided.

The trustees hereinbefore named shall not be required to give bond or make any return to any court.

Item Fifth. Should the trustees herein named decline to accept the trust hereby created then it is my desire that the Superior Court appoint a trustee who shall give bond and make the returns required of

all trustees in terms of the law.

Item Sixth: Should the Trustee or the Executor herein named be unable to agree upon any question touching the management or disposition of my estate, then I desire that the same be submitted to all my children and the voice of a majority shall control.

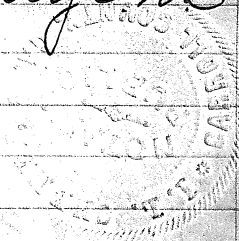
Item Seventh. I hereby constitute and appoint my three sons, viz: W. J., L. H., and Edwin Stewart as the Executors to carry out the provisions of this my last will and testament.
