Item 2 I desire and direct that all my  
just debts be paid without delay by my  
Treasurer appointed

Item 3- I give bequeath and devise to my  
beloved son Standrick P. Barnett all that  
land 40 1/2 acres more or less situate  
in the 5th of the District of Columbia  
that portion of said lot which was  
given to H. J. Lewis of said County on date  
16th of September 1871 with all the rights, claims  
and appurtenances or in any way  
in anywise belonging to or appurtenant  
and in anywise connected with the same

Item 4- I give bequeath and devise to my beloved  
son Standrick P. Barnett all my personal  
property of every kind and kind

Item 5- I give bequeath and devise to my beloved  
son Standrick P. Barnett all that  
contract or title to the land in the  
description of which is set forth in  
and therein is contained in the  
No 137 in the 5th District of Columbia  
a side by which it is otherwise, by  
the land mentioned in said deed  
with to me, all of said lot in the  
unassured as that portion mentioned in the  
3rd. Item of this my last and testament

Item 6th I give bequeath to my  
daughter Sarah A. Barnett the wife of James  
B. Campbell one dollar

Item 7th- I hereby constitute and appo-  
int my beloved son Standrick P. Barnett  
my executor of this my last will & Testament  
This given 7th 1872 Absalom Barnett

1st I revoke the 5th of said Will and amend the same - and hereby adopt the said agenda in Item 3rd. of said Will executed on the 16th Sept. 1871 to W. S. Lewis of said County, so far as to give to said W. S. Lewis, the 110 acres of the said Lot of Land No 157, 3<sup>rd</sup> District of Carroll as which in said deed hereby made, said deed absolute unless hereafter revoked by me in any lifetime and in event of the death of said Lewis to comply as his part with his other contracts, which I hold also to annul and void by any last Will - and also adopt the following in lieu of a part of said 3<sup>rd</sup> Item. I reserve to any other property real or personal belonging to me at my death not already disposed of hereby give and bequeath to my said son Shadrach P. Barnett, except as to my Bed Bedding and Bedstead and my Bureau

Item 4<sup>th</sup> of said Will, I charge so far as to give and bequeath of any personal property to Mrs. Cecelia W. Lewis my be- bequest of said bequest.

And I further order that said deed to said Lewis for said 110 acres of said Lot shall not be revoked without due notice to said Lewis with the payment for such revocation this June 10<sup>th</sup>. 1873
