in life - and my said I do shall return to him
who gave it - and I do give to him

Through the merits and intercession of the Hon. Lord and Governor James Blair.

Item 2 I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executor hereinafter appointed.

Item 3- I give bequeath and devise to my beloved Son Shadrach P. Barnett all that certain parcel of land to wit 20 acres more or less situate in the 5th Civil District of said County to wit the West portion of said lot and residue then devised given to H. T. Lewis of said County and dated 16th of September 1871. With all the rights, revenues and appurtenances or any and every land in any wise belonging to or growing out of the same and all rights and interests thereto.

Item 4- I give and bequeath to my beloved son Shadrach P. Barnett all my personal property of every kind and description.

Item 5- I give and bequeath to my beloved son Shadrach P. Barnett all that certain lot the contents whereof is set out in the 3rd line of the 1st section of said Act to wit the 137 in the 5th Civil District of said County to wit a side by which it is otherwise, by which the land mentioned in said Deed Deed should revert to me, all of said lot is the same as was in that portion mentioned in the 3rd. Item of this my last and Testament.

Item 6th- I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah A. Barnett all my property of every kind and description.

Item 7th- I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved son Shadrach P. Barnett my Executor of this my last will & Testament. This given 9th 1872. Absalom Barnett

Putnam and Bennett Lewis who signed the said Will and Testament as witnesses - and whereas I am desirous of attesting and carrying some of the bequests and devises in said Will into effect make and publish this codicil to said Will -

1st I revoke Clause 9th of said Will and amend the same - and hereby adopt the devise herein in Item 3rd of said Will executed on the 16th Sept. 1872 to W. T. Lewis of said County, so far as to give to said W. T. Lewis, the 110 acres of the said Lot of Land in 15th & 16th District of Carroll described in said deed hereby made, and said deed absolute unless hereafter revoked by me in any lifetime on account of the neglect of said Lewis to comply on his part with his mother's contract, which I hold also to annul and void by my last Will - and also adopt the following in lieu of a part of said 3rd Section Item any other property real or personal belonging to me at my death not already disposed of hereby give and bequeath to my said son Shadrach P. Barnette, as much as to my Bed Bedding and Bedstead and any Bureau

Item 4th of said Will I change so far as to give and bequeath of my personal property to Mrs. Elizabeth W. Lewis my late bedstead and bureau.

And I further order that said deed to said Lewis for said 110 acres of said Lot shall not be revoked without due notice to said Lewis with the power for such revocation this June 12th 1873
