I give and bequeath and leave to my beloved wife Nancy Isannah  
fraction of Lot of land No 304 in the 5th Dist of Carroll County with  
all the rights members and appurtenances to said fraction  
of Land in my wife belonging free from all charge and inci-  
tation whatever together with the balance of my effects both  
real and personal to her own proper use benefit and behalf pro-  
viding full power to dispose of the same by will or other wise as she
