full power to sell and make a lawful title to lot land No
1205 two hundred and five in the original tenth district of
said County at any time during her widowhood

Article 4th

I nominate constitute and appoint my wife Eliza
M Robison and T E Holmes the Executors of my last will and
Testament - This the 20th day of May 1865.
