

Last Will and Testament of Josiah K. Barr.

State of Georgia, Carroll County.

I, Josiah K. Barr being of sound mind and disposing memory and knowing that our bodies are mortal and must soon pass to the tomb do make and publish this as my last will and testament hereby revoking all others by me made.

Item 1st

It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid as early after my death as practicable and convenient.

Item 2nd

I will and bequeath to my daughter Mary Ann C. McWhorter and her heirs for their separate use not to be subject to the control of any one, but her and her heirs Two hundred dollars which they have already received the benefit of, in east half of lot of land No 4 in the Eleventh of Carroll also the cow and calf and the sheep that I gave her soon after she was married for her entire part.

Item 3rd

I will and bequeath to my daughter Martha Ann Chambers the cow and sheep worth twenty five dollars which I gave her after her marriage and five dollars in money to be paid out of my estate for her entire part of my estate.

Item 4th

I will and bequeath my beloved wife Jane O. Barr the house and benefit of the plantation her lifetime or as much thereof as is necessary for her support to be controlled by my executors.

It is my desire for my beloved wife to have all the kitchen and household furniture her lifetime.

Item 5th

It is my will and desire that all my property be divided equally between my children and the daughters of my deceased son George A. Barr except Mary Ann C. McWhorter and Martha Ann Chambers is not to be included. Their parts is set apart as shown above.

Item 6th

It is my will and desire that my executors have the power to sell real estate or personal property at public sale or private sale at their discretion.

Item 7th

It is my will and desire that J. C. Barr and J. H. Barr act as executors of this will.
