property. At my death to have and to hold to their own
property forever there and there alike.

4th In consideration of the foregoing bequests it is that
my two said grand children and the said Augustus Beams
shall take care of me during my natural life providing
me with board and clothing and medical attendance when
necessary washing for me and otherwise attending upon me
as my health may demand.

5th I hereby constitute and appoint Adam Powell
Executor of this my last will and testament.
