All my land part of lot (No 166) One hundred and Sixty Six
Said parcel of land lying in the north west corner of said
lot containing one hundred acres more or less - Part of lot

the south west corner of said lot number of Acres not
known & lot No 127 One hundred and twenty seven contain
ing 202 1/2 Acres more or less all in the third District - Carroll
County Originally And my beloved wife to live upon said
land to raise my said Children
6th Item the residue of my property both real & personal
wherever & whatever it may be including that given to my
beloved wife Ann agreeable to the true Specified in the
fore part of this my last Will and Testament
