family and myself that I should make a disposition
of the property with which a kind providence has blessed
me do therefore make this my last Will and Testament
hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me

I Item 1st

I desire and direct that my body be buried
in a decent and christianlike manner suitable to
my circumstances and condition in life. My soul I
trust shall return to rest with God who gave it as I hope
for eternal salvation through the merits and atonement of
the blessed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ whose religion
I have professed and as I humbly trust for two years

I Item the 2^d
Second

I desire and direct that all my just debts
be paid without delay by my executor and Exec-
utors hereinafter appointed so I am unwilling
my creditors be delayed in their rights

I Item the 3rd

I give bequeath and devise to my

beloved wife Margaret Copeland with whom I have lived in the strictest quiet for forty five years lot of land number one hundred and thirty six in the ninth district of Carroll County Georgia containing two hundred two and one half acres with all the rights members and appurtenances to said lot of land in anywise belonging during her life time and after her death to be sold and first pay my son Johnathan one hundred dollars second pay my son William T one hundred dollars and a horse saddle and bridle worth seventy five dollars 3^d Pay Jane thirty dollars 4th Pay Sarah Ann thirty dollars and then all the balance of my property to be equally divided between all of my children with the exception of my Bible and rifle which I give and bequeath to my son William Copeland Item the fourth

I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Margaret Copeland my Executor and my beloved son Johnathan Copeland my Executor of this my last will and testament this August the 22^d 1867
