- Item third. To my daughter Mary Jane Foot I give bequeath and devise Two Hundred Dollars.
- Item fourth. To my daughter Sarah Colles children I give bequeath and devise Two hundred Dollars.
- Item fifth. To my daughter Martha Bantrell I give bequeath and devise Two Hundred Dollars.
- Item sixth. To my daughter Susan Bigge children I give bequeath and devise Two hundred Dollars.
- Item seventh. To my daughter Fanny B. Bigge I give and bequeath and devise Two hundred Dollars.
- Item eighth. To my grand son James Crockett I give bequeath and devise one hundred Dollars.
- Item ninth. The residence of my estate if any shall be at the disposal of my Wife Sarah Crockett.
- Item tenth. I hereby constitute and appoint my Friend James P. Griffin Executor of this my last will and testament this 26th day of May 1884.
